- (1) When gathering service is performed for barrels gathered into Slaughter Station from Frazier GS, Yellowhouse GS, and Veal GS [I] 61.42¢ per Barrel will be added to the rate named in this column except for barrels gathered to Mallet Station from various gathering systems and barrels gathered to Monroe Station WTI from the Anton Irish gathering system. See Centurion Pipeline L.P.'s F.E.R.C. Tariff No. [W] 44.70.0 ~~44.67.0~~ and subsequent reissues thereof for current gathering rates into Mallet Station.
- (2) The quality of Crude Petroleum delivered to Cushing, Oklahoma from Slaughter Station, Smyer Station, or Monroe Station can only be Domestic Sweet/West Texas Intermediate (WTI) with a sulfur content of 0.4% or less.
- (3) The Crude Petroleum received at Slaughter Station for delivery to Cushing, Oklahoma under the "Permian Sour Blend" service shall be a Sour Blend with a density not exceeding 0.94 specific gravity (grams per milliliter) at 60 degrees Fahrenheit and a sulfur content not exceeding 3.7% by weight.
- (4) For further rates and routing, please see Centurion Pipeline L.P.'s F.E.R.C. No. [W] 44.70.0 ~~44.67.0~~ and subsequent reissues thereof.
- (5) Applicable to shipments of Crude Petroleum by any Shipper that executes and has an effective throughput and deficiency agreement with Centurion, under which such Shipper commits to ship at least 50,000 barrels per day of "Permian Sour Blend," as described in Note 3, on Centurion's pipeline system from Slaughter Station, Texas to Cushing, Oklahoma.
- (6) Centurion is including the Table of Combined Rates for convenience only. The Table of Combined Rates has no impact on Centurion's operations or the application of its rules and regulations, including the prorationing and nomination procedures. Therefore, Shippers should continue submitting nominations in accordance with current practices and Centurion's rules and regulations tariff, F.E.R.C. No. 35.10.0 and subsequent reissues thereof. In addition, the notes set forth in this tariff, where applicable, shall continue to apply to the relevant components of the combined movements set forth in the Table of Combined Rates.

Slaughter Station, Texas to Midland Tank Farm, Texas: Slaughter Station to Mallet Station (Table of Rates, F.E.R.C. No. [W] 41.32.0 ~~41.31.0~~), connecting to: Mallet Station for delivery to Midland Tank Farm (F.E.R.C. No. [W] 44.70.0 ~~44.67.0~~).
