Notes**(1) Pumpover Charge**

When Crude Petroleum is moved from the Pecos System through Centurion Pipeline L.P.'s facility at Artesia Station into the Holly Refinery, a [I] 25.92¢ per Barrel fee will be charged.

(2) Truck Unloading

Where trucks are unloaded on Centurion Pipeline L.P.'s main line, a special handling charge of [I] 28.77¢ per Barrel will be added to the trunk line rate in effect.

(3) Incentive Rate

An incentive rate of [I] 98.49¢ per Barrel will apply to any Shipper that has entered into and has an effective dedication agreement with Centurion or any Shipper shipping on behalf of a producer that has entered into and has an effective dedication agreement with Centurion with respect to gathering and trunk line service from Dagger Draw to Artesia Station.
