*The incentive rate will apply to any shipper that has executed a Transportation Services Agreement (TSA) with Carriers on or before January 31, 2021 committing to ship, or pay a deficiency for failure to ship, a minimum quantity of 22,500 barrels per day of Crude Petroleum for a minimum term of seventy-eight (78) months. Once the confidentiality agreement is executed, the tariff compiler will deliver the form TSA to the interested shipper.
